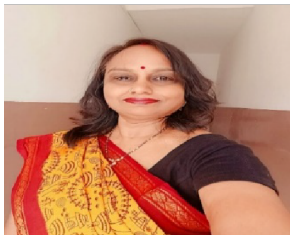

Summary of Sessions (Day-wise Highlights):**Day 1 (08th Sept. 2025):**

The first day 08th September, 2025, Dr. Rahul Manjare anchored the event - the Inauguration of the programme started with Prof. Dr. S. B. Sawant Director of the AKIMSS welcome address, he provided the institute progress report. He focused upon the various initiatives for student and faculty development taken by the institute.

The speaker has experience of 24 years of Industry and Academia. Mr. James Ruddy, started his speech with his experience of using AI applications in every operation of his business activities. He opinioned that AI has covered majority fields in education sector, Engineering, Medical, Commerce and Management, Architecture, Data Sciences, Robotics, Space and Aviation etc. He said that the key to embracing AI in education is finding the right balance where AI enhances rather than replaces human instruction, maintaining the essential human elements of education like creativity, critical thinking and emotional support that teachers provide.

Question and Answer session was conducted where sir answered all the queries of the audience. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by, Dr. Rahul Manjare.

Session –II: AI – Powered Personalized Learning, began at 8:00 PM Dr. Ganraj Mane, introduced the Key Speaker Dr. Anuradha Kanade, Program Director at MIT – World Peace University, Pune. The speaker has 21 years of Teaching experience in the capacity of senior faculty. Speaker Dr. Anuradha Kanade started her speech with explaining that Artificial Intelligence (AI) is transforming education by making the teaching–learning process more **efficient, engaging, and learner-centered**. It helps educators personalize instruction, reduce repetitive tasks, and provide students with tailored learning experiences. She provided explanation of various AI Tools i.e. Google Classroom, Duolingo, Khanmigo, Coursera etc. AI mentors, adaptive curricula linked to careers, predictive analytics for guidance are some of anticipated developments.

Question and Answer session was conducted where madam answered all the queries of the audience. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by, Dr. Ganraj Mane.

Day 2 (09th Sept. 2025):

Session –III: Intelligent Tutoring System (ITS), began at 6:00 PM Prof. Vaishali Patel madam, introduced the key speaker Dr. Suyog Amrutrao, Director, Department of Management Studies, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Sub Campus, Dharashiv, sir has 20 years of teaching experience. The speaker began his talk with application of AI in Marketing Management, product branding and positioning can be done with ease. Sir discussed the features of AI in Teaching and Learning methodology, Intelligent Tutoring System (ITS) is Text – based chat, students can send learn through Quizzes & Dashboards, Business Simulations and Gamified environments. The AI Apps like Khanmigo, Duolingo, ALEKS, ELSA Speak, Quizlet, DreamBox Learning are the new avenues helping ITS.

Question and Answer session was conducted where Dr. Suyog Amrutrao answered all the queries of the audience. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by, Prof. Vaishali Patel madam.

Session –IV: AI in Assessment and Evaluation, began at 7:30 PM Dr. Shabnam Mane madam, introduced the key speaker Dr. Govind P. Shinde, Director at Indira Institute of Management, Mumbai, sir has 27 years of teaching experience in various educational institutes. Speaker opened his talk by putting forth the challenges and opportunities in AI. He explained that tools like Turnitin, Kritik, PractorU, DreamBox Learning, edx are introduced to assess and validate the content. Learning Management System (LMS) like Canvas, Blackboard and D2L are embedding AI Features, they include predictive analytics to identify at risk students, automated nudges and smart content recommendations. Sir concluded that the role of the instructor is evolving to become an interpreter of AI – generated insights and a learning facilitator.

Question and Answer session was conducted where speaker Dr. Govind P. Shinde answered all the queries of the audience. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by, Dr. Shabnam Mane madam.

Day 3 (10th Sept. 2025):

Session –V: AI for Learning Analytics, began at 6:00 PM Prof. C. R. Suryawanshi Sir, introduced the key speaker Dr. Amol A. Pahatak, Head, CSE (AI&DS) Dept. Shree Siddheshwar Women's College of Engineering, Solapur. Dr. Pahatak started his talk, He precisely Specified the difference between traditional analytics and AI analytics. further he explained that AI analytics is useful for academic research, institutional decision making and administration. he covered basics of data driven approach in education, sources of data, learning management system different platforms like Canvas, Moodle, blackboards, online assessment surveys, students infractions, biometric and behavioral signals, Catboats for students, auto generating assignments, personalized study materials, applications of personalized learning paths adaptive content and its applications. He demonstrated three different case studies for better understating of the concept.

Finally, Prof. C. R. Suryawanshi gave concluding remark and offered Vote of thanks.

Session –VI: Catbots and Virtual Assistants in Education, Dr. A. B. Nadaf sir introduced to speaker Dr. Pramod Kadam, Information Security Specialist at Amdocs, Pune. who has 20 years of academic and industry experience. Dr. Pramod Kadam explained the growth of the conventional AI. Chat boat is not new phenomenon it has evolved in the way back in 1960 he said. As Natural Language Processing and Machine Learning processing brought significant advancement in AI. Today due to adoption of smartphone and adoption of social media conventional AI is transforming industries from customer services, education and healthcare services. He exposed the key features and capabilities of conventional AI. Natural Language Understanding, Contextual Awareness, Machine Learning, Integrations with other systems. He highlighted that now days huge work is going on LLM ie Large Language Model it requires development environment like Jupiter Lab, Spider lab etc Programming language like Python, C++, Julia, R it require the system CPU/GPU He stressed on why virtual assistant is really required in the era of CHAT GPT. Chat-Gpt is powerful tool for open end learning and exploration and virtual assistants remain essential structured secured and integrated educational support. He highlighted the Challenges and limitations of Chat boat and virtual assistant.

Finally Dr.A.B.Nadaf gave concluding remark and offered vote of thank for the session.

Day 4 (11th Sept. 2025):

Session –VII: Ethical and Privacy concerns in AI – based Education, Dr. Shivganga Maindargi provided the introduction of key resource person Dr. Ritesh Kumar Singh, Product Manager at John Deere India Private Limited, Pune. Dr. Ritesh Kumar Singh, said AI is transforming the educational landscape through personalized learning, automated grading, intelligent tutoring systems, and more. However, the integration of AI in education raises several ethical and privacy concerns that must be carefully addressed. He gave following concerns AI systems collect vast amounts of data including academic records, behavioral patterns, and even biometric data. if it is not properly protected, this data can be breaches unauthorized access and misused. He added AI models may reinforce existing biases due to biased training data. Examples: Unequal treatment of students based on race, gender, or socioeconomic background. It Can lead to unfair grading, recommendations, or learning outcomes. As vast use of AI in education there is lack of transparency, AI algorithms often operate opaquely, making it difficult for educators or students to understand how decisions are made. Dehumanization of Learning further stated that although there is a technological advancement any AI cannot replace Guru. Because knowledge you can generate but what about human touch. In conclusion he emphasizes that While AI has the potential to revolutionize education, it is crucial to implement these technologies responsibly. Ensuring transparency, fairness, security, and respect for human dignity must be at the core of AI integration in education.

Question and Answer session was conducted where speaker Dr. Ritesh Kumar Singh answered all the queries of the audience. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by, Dr. Shivganga Maindargi.

Session – VIII: Integrating AI in Curriculum Design, Prof. D. D. Mhetre introduced the speaker Dr. Sudhakar D. Bhoite Dean & Asso. Professor, School of Computer Science & Applications SIBER, Kolhapur who has experience of 30 years in teaching. The speaker began his talk with the information about that use of computers in education are primarily aimed towards: Increasing accessibility – Learning resources can be accessed from anywhere, at any time. AI is facilitating personalized learning inside and outside the classroom, Learning can be tailored and adapted to each student's goals and abilities through personalized programs. Time – consuming, tedious tasks such as record keeping or grading multiple – choice tests can be completed through AI automation and exploring fundamental questions about how people learn.

Predictive Analytics: use of data, statistical models, and AI to forecast future outcomes and trends. Computer Vision: enables machines to interpret and analyze visual information from images or videos. Automation: perform tasks with minimal human intervention,

improving efficiency and accuracy. Recommendation System: AI-driven tools that suggest relevant products, content or actions.

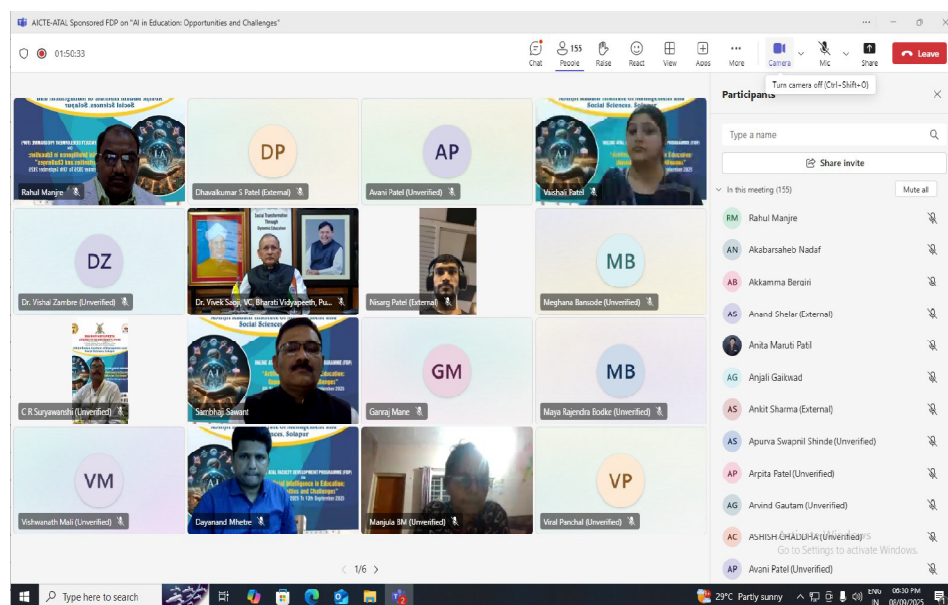
learning experiences tailored to individual students, increased efficiency for educators and administrators, greater inclusion and accessibility for diverse learners.
