INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP - NEONATAL RESUSCITATION , 7th November 2025

Neonatal Resuscitation Workshop was organized by the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology Nursing, Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Nursing, Pune, on 7th November 2025 under the theme "Golden Minute Matters: Empowering Hands for Newborn Life." The program aimed to enhance the knowledge and practical skills of nursing students and healthcare professionals in performing timely and effective neonatal resuscitation to reduce preventable newborn deaths.

The session commenced with a warm welcome address by **Dr. Pravin Dani, Vice Principal**, Bharati Vidyapeeth, College of Nursing Pune, followed by an inaugural speech by **Dr. Bhagyashree Jogdeo, Principal**, Bharati Vidyapeeth, College of Nursing Pune, who emphasized the importance of skilled intervention during the first minute after birth—the "golden minute"—for ensuring newborn survival.

Expert resource persons **Ms. Linta Wyke Lungblad, Faculty Of USN University**, Norway conducted informative sessions on topics including the *Principles of Neonatal Resuscitation, Initial Steps of Newborn Care, Airway Management, Chest Compressions, and Use of Resuscitation Equipment*. Participants were given hands-on training using mannequins and resuscitation kits, ensuring they gained confidence and competence in life-saving techniques.

The workshop was highly interactive, with demonstrations, and return demonstrations simulations, and group discussions, conducted by **Dr. K. Memchoubi, Dr. Supriya Pottal Ray, Dr. Sujita Devi, Mrs. Manisha Gadade, Mrs. Sonali Atre and Ms. Deepali Borde**. that encouraged active participation. Students expressed great enthusiasm and appreciated the opportunity to strengthen their clinical skills through realistic practice.

The event concluded with feedback from participants, acknowledging the efforts of faculty members, organizers, and participants for making the workshop a success. Certificates of participation were distributed to all attendees.

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Teaching non pharmacological method of pain relief like deep breathing exercises, walking around the ward,➤ Assessment of the fetal wellbeing using CTG,➤ Performing per vaginal examination.➤ Conduct delivery independently and kept baby on mother's abdomen and late cord cutting in 3minutes.➤ They were taught to take care of women during intra-partum period.➤ They even witnessed some cases of MTP and PPIUCD.➤ High risk condition like PPH was also able to witness during the labour room posting.➤ They perform episiotomy and suturing. Immediate care of the newborn was provided, perform suctioning of the baby, given VitK, Zero dose of Polio, Hep b vaccine.➤ They also learn about the use of various medications during the labour like Oxytocin, Drotin, Buscopan, Epidosin Etc.➤ After delivery they help mother to initiate breast feeding. 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



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
