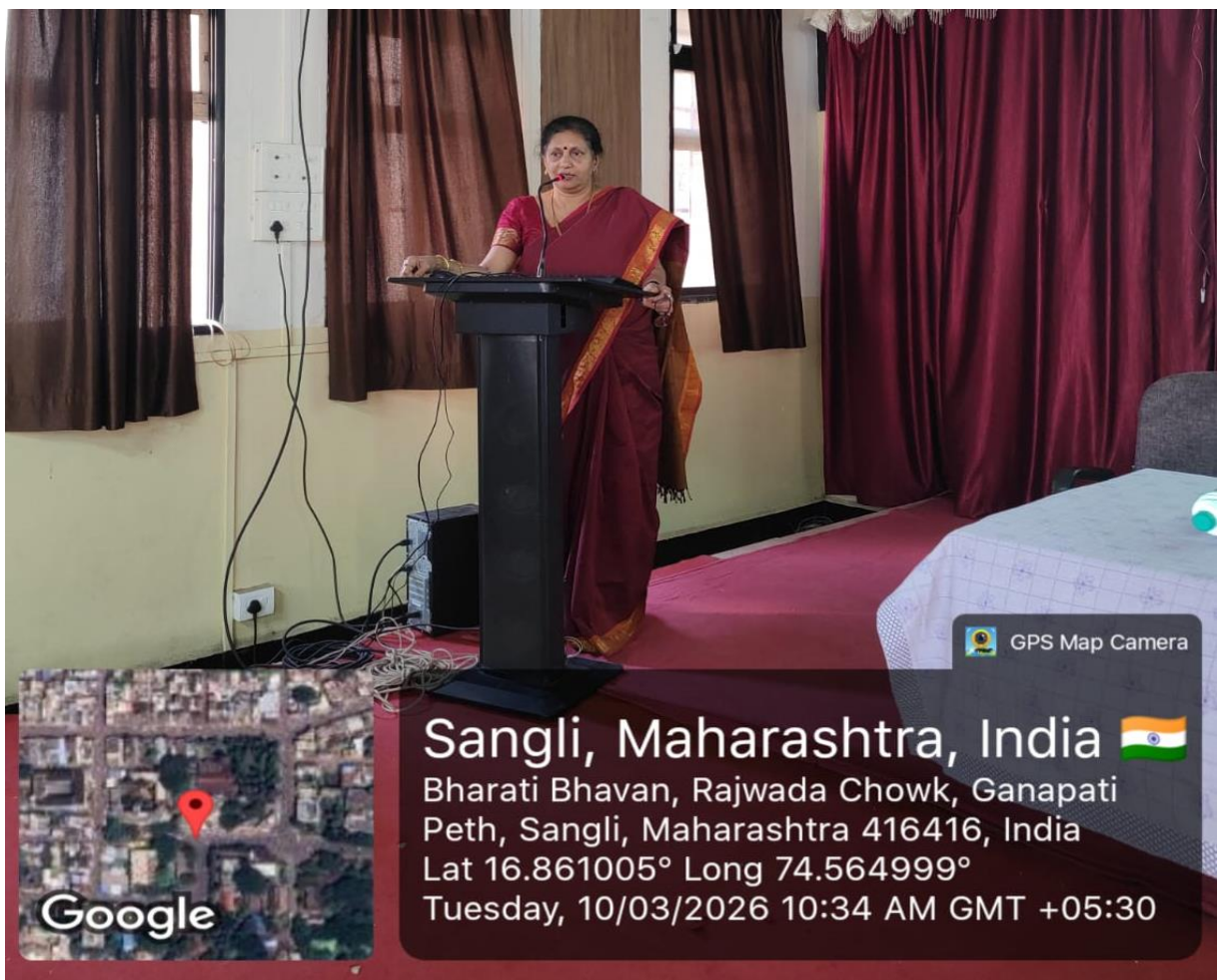


Value Added Course on Women Empowerment

A Value Added Course on Women Empowerment was organized from 10th to 12th March 2026 for the girl students of Second and Third Year BBA and BCA. The program aimed to create awareness among girls about self-development, safety, health, career planning, and entrepreneurship. A total of 134 students participated in the three-day course. Renowned experts from different fields were invited to guide the students.

Day 1 – 10th March 2026

The course was inaugurated by Dr. Jaya Kurhekar, Retired Professor of Microbiology from Shivaji University and an environmentalist. She guided the students on home remedies and the importance of traditional medicines in daily life.

The second session was conducted by Dr. Yojana Jugale, Retired Principal of Annasaheb Dange Arts, Commerce and Science College, Hatkanangale. She shared her personal experiences and insights on career planning, motivating students to overcome challenges and pursue their goals confidently.

Day 2 – 11th March 2026

The first session was conducted by Mrs. Khot and her colleague from Nirbhaya Pathak, Sangli. They educated students about safety issues faced by girls in daily life and ways to protect themselves. They also informed students about police helplines and support systems available for women.

The second session was delivered by Dr. Pooja Narwadkar, Principal of New Law College, Sangli. Her lecture focused on “Sexual Harassment at Workplace.” She explained the legal provisions and rights available to women, helping students understand how the law protects them in such situations.

Day 3 – 12th March 2026

The first session was conducted by Dr. Nilima Bhore, Retired Dean and Principal of BVDU Nursing College, Sangli. She delivered an informative talk on hygiene and healthy food habits, emphasizing the importance of maintaining good health and cleanliness.
