opportunities.

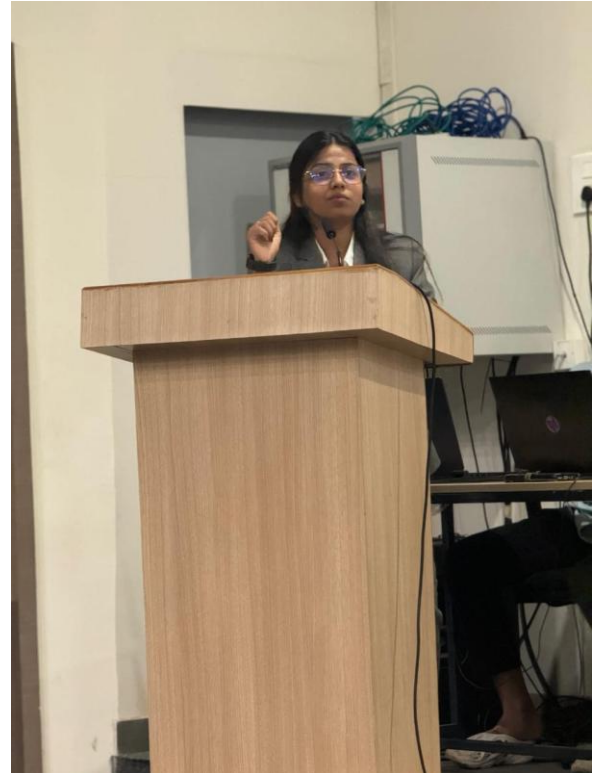
Heads up and rapid fire game : 3:25
