- To encourage students to pursue knowledge and careers in cybersecurity and digital forensics.

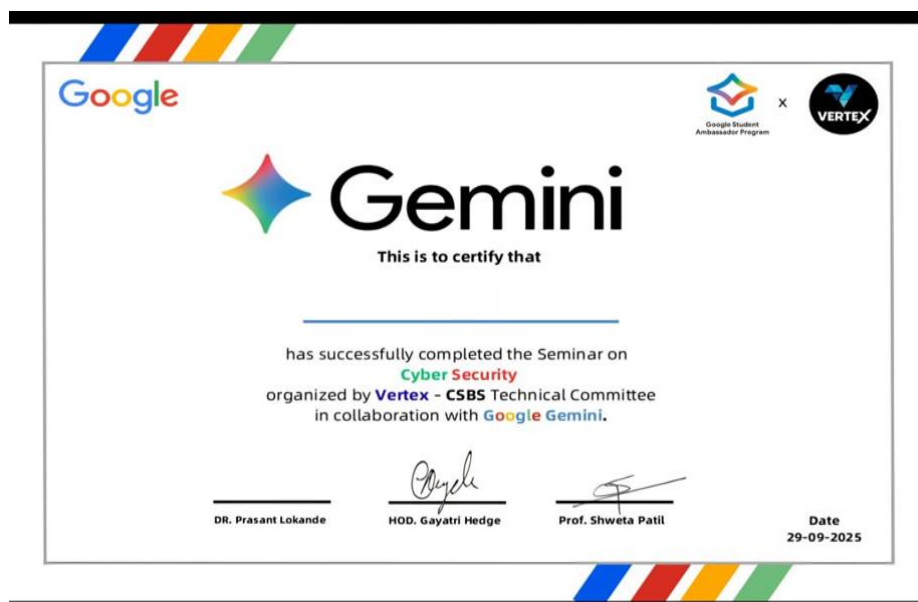
Event Highlights
