Details of the Activity:

A workshop on “**Maternal Care: Essential Skills**” was organized by the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology Nursing, Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Nursing, Pune, on 2nd April 2026. The aim was to enhance the knowledge and practical skills of nursing students in essential obstetric procedures to reduce maternal mortality and morbidity. The program began with a welcome address by Dr. Pravin Dani, Vice Principal, followed by an inaugural speech by Dr. Bhagyashree Jogdeo, Principal, emphasizing the importance of skilled interventions in obstetric emergencies. Students from TYGNM and Sem VI participated actively. FYMSc Nursing students demonstrated procedures such as partograph management, episiotomy and suturing, mechanism of labour, conducting delivery, and postnatal care. The workshop included demonstrations, return demonstrations, and group discussions conducted by faculty members including Dr. K. Memchoubi, Dr. Supriya Pottal Ray, Dr. Sujita Devi, Mrs. Manisha Gadade, Mrs. Sonali Atre, Ms. Nikita Jaybhay, and Ms. Deepali Borde. The session was highly interactive, and students appreciated the opportunity to strengthen their clinical skills through hands-on practice.
