Minutes of HOD meeting (5th February, 2026)

1. DASCA Proposal:

2. Admission:

Care must be taken for the offline registration, as those authors will be available as an audience.

4. ERP:

Now we all are using ERP software for all entries. Every faculty and non-teaching staff should use it for various entries. Heads should ensure about the same. All entries must be checked properly.

5. Academic Audit:

For the academic audit, a separate format will be given by Vice Principal Madam. For the same dates are decided like 12th and 13th March 2026. All departments should be ready with necessary documents and format given by the authority.

Please make a definite plan to ensure the presence and participation of students and faculty members.

a) ZP Elections: Faculty members (Teaching/ non-teaching) having voting for the ZP elections can go for the voting if names are in a voting list by informing in the respective department.

b) Dead Stock Verification: Dr. Prakash Chaven Sir and team will do the needful, Necessary instructions were given in a meeting by Principal Sir.

c) Academic Monitoring: As per previous meeting, every head must give the information about the academic monitoring till 6th Feb.2026. Hence, all should have given the information.

d) Placement: In a meeting discussion was held on placement also. Now, placement is good. Important thing is any international placement is required; it will show best results.

e) HR Meet: On 13th and 14th March 2026 our engineering college and other engineering colleges under our umbrella are going to arrange one HR meet. We are trying, to call maximum HR from various companies. One cultural night will be arranged followed by dinner.
