Report on Advanced Neonatal Programme Provider Course

The faculty members of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) College of Nursing, Sangli—Dr. Dhanraj Babu, Dr. Aparna Bhushan Kale, and Mrs. Shaila Mathew—attended the Advanced Neonatal Programme (ANP) Provider Course organized by the Indian Academy of Paediatrics, Sangli, and conducted by the Department of Paediatrics, Government Medical College, Sangli, on 5th April 2026 from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM. The programme commenced with sessions on preparation for newborns who may require resuscitation, emphasizing the importance of appropriate environment, trained personnel, and essential equipment. The resource persons delivered comprehensive sessions on routine neonatal care, systematic assessment, and early identification of neonates requiring intervention. The training further covered critical life-saving procedures such as Positive Pressure Ventilation (PPV), endotracheal intubation, and chest compressions, along with detailed guidance on post-resuscitation care. Hands-on practice formed a key component of the programme, where all participants actively re-demonstrated Neonatal Resuscitation Programme (NRP) procedures through various simulated scenarios. The programme was highly interactive and provided an excellent platform for enhancing knowledge and developing practical skills in neonatal resuscitation and care.
