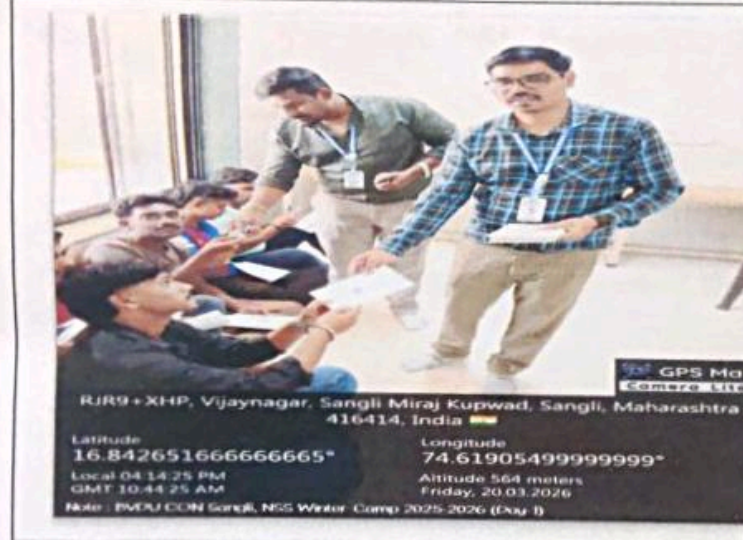
The day concluded with great enthusiasm, reinforcing the NSS motto: **“Not Me, But You.”**

The day concluded with great enthusiasm, reinforcing the NSS motto: **“Not Me, But You.”**

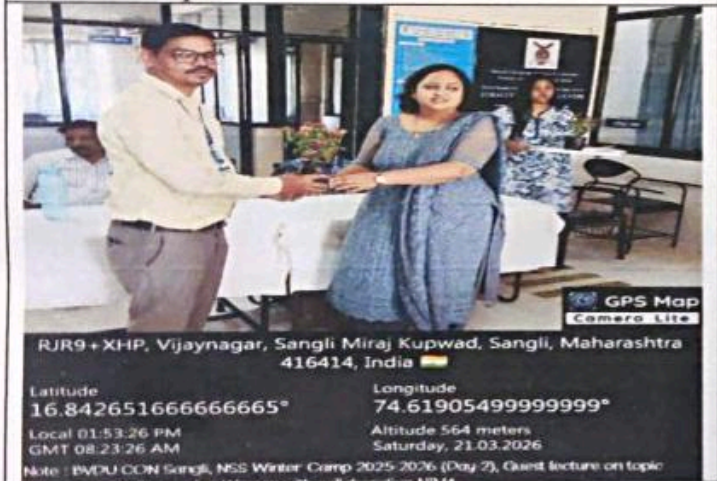
