### **Report of Session on Nebulization Therapy**

Under the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between I Med Source India, Glenmark and Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to University) College of Nursing Pune, a highly enriching academic session on Nebulization therapy was conducted on 24/04/2026 from 09:00 AM to 11:00 AM at Authentication hall of BV(DU)CON, Pune, wherein the faculty delivered a detailed and clinically oriented presentation integrating both theoretical foundations and practical application; the session comprehensively covered the concept and principles of aerosol drug delivery, types of nebulizers (jet, ultrasonic, and mesh), indications such as bronchial asthma, COPD, and other respiratory conditions, drug selection and dilution, dosage accuracy, advantages and limitations, contraindications, and strict infection control practices, along with emphasis on patient assessment and safety considerations before, during, and after the procedure; this was followed by a systematic live demonstration, where faculty showcased the complete nebulization procedure including equipment preparation, correct assembly, medication loading, optimal patient positioning, administration technique, monitoring of patient response, and post-procedure care, thereby bridging the gap between theory and clinical practice; the session was highly interactive and evolved into an effective doubt-clearing forum, with participants actively raising queries related to technique, troubleshooting, complications, and real-time clinical scenarios, all of which were addressed with practical insights by the



faculty, making the session informative, skill-oriented, and instrumental in enhancing the clinical competence and confidence of the participants.
