Report on Pragati Project under KEDMAN SkillEd India foundation

Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) College of Nursing, Sangli, under the guidance of Principal Dr. Suresh Kumar Ray, successfully implemented the *Pragati Project* under KEDMAN SkillEd India foundation in collaboration with Honda India at Bharati Hospital. The primary objective of this initiative was to enhance the skills and competencies of hospital workers. The program aimed to strengthen patient care services by providing structured training through the General Duty Assistant (GDA) course, while also promoting awareness about road safety and community responsibility. A total of 50 beneficiaries actively participated in this program.

The course commenced on 04 November 2025 with an orientation session conducted by Mr. Saurabh, Project Coordinator. The training program was systematically organized using educational videos prepared by the Pragati Project in Hindi, which served as the core teaching material. To ensure better understanding among participants, the content was explained in Marathi by the trainers, Mrs. Shaila Mathew, Asst. Professor and Mr. Samson Kamble, Clinical Instructor, BV(DU) CON, Sangli. This bilingual approach proved highly effective in bridging language barriers and facilitating active participation and engagement among the beneficiaries.

The sessions covered various aspects of patient care, including hospital admission procedures, care of patients in wards as well as in the ICU, communication with patients, discharge procedures, handling of equipment, and post-mortem care. This training equipped the participants with essential knowledge and practical skills required for their roles as General Duty Assistants.

In addition to the GDA training, special focus was given to road safety awareness. From 5 December 2025 to 29 December 2025, a 15-day online lecture series on road safety was conducted alongside the regular training sessions. These sessions addressed important topics such as traffic rules and regulations, the importance of following safety measures, and strategies to prevent road accidents. The sessions were interactive in nature, encouraging

participants to share their experiences and clarify their doubts, thereby making the learning process more engaging and impactful.

As part of experiential learning, the beneficiaries were taken on a visit to a nearby Honda showroom. This field visit provided them with practical exposure to vehicle safety features and reinforced their understanding of road safety concepts. It also helped in connecting theoretical knowledge with real-life applications, making the learning experience more meaningful.

Furthermore, the participants actively engaged in community outreach activities related to road safety. They conducted awareness programs within the community, educating the public on safe road practices and the importance of adhering to traffic rules. These activities not only enhanced their confidence and communication skills but also instilled a sense of social responsibility. Beneficiaries who actively participated in these initiatives were awarded certificates in recognition of their efforts and contributions.

The General Duty Assistant course proved to be highly beneficial and effective in improving the overall quality of patient care within the hospital. Participants demonstrated improved skills, a better understanding of patient needs, and increased confidence in performing their duties. The training also contributed to the development of a more competent and efficient healthcare support workforce.

The program concluded with a valedictory function attended by hospital authorities, Mr. Saurabh Ajaykumar Gupta, Asst.Manger KEDMAN SkillEd India foundation, Mr. Suhas from Tricolour Honda, Miraj and Mr. Rajendra from Riverside Honda Sangli. The event marked the successful completion of the training program and included the distribution of certificates to participants. It also provided an opportunity to acknowledge the efforts of the trainers and beneficiaries, as well as to reflect on the achievements of the program.

In conclusion, the Pragati Project under the Skill India Initiative, in collaboration with Honda India, was a highly impactful program that successfully achieved its objectives. It not only enhanced the professional skills of beneficiaries but also promoted awareness about road safety and community engagement. The program has made a significant contribution toward improving patient care quality and fostering responsible citizenship, thereby serving as a model for similar initiatives in the future.

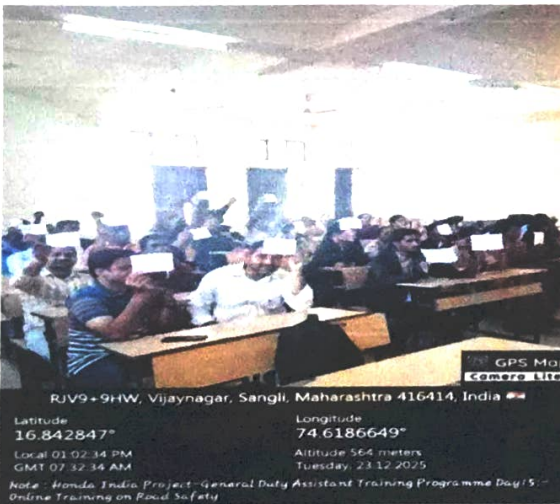

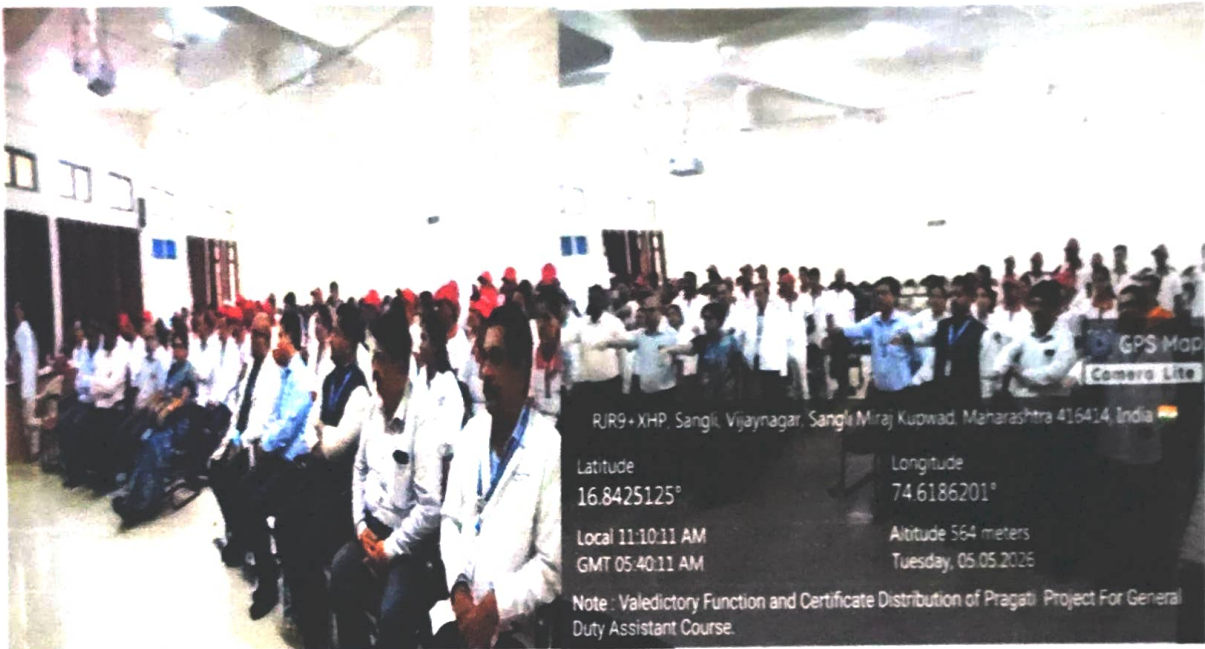
